We should all be aware that cell phone calls to 911 are ineffective. Use a LAND LINE if possible and program your local emergency numbers into the cell phone.

If the ambulance has lights and siren, pull over and stop. If the lights and siren aren't going, no need to pull over.

Let the emergency responders know where you are! Send someone out to the street, out to the corner, out to the end of the driveway.

Don't hang up on 911. As they give you information, they are sending people to you! Be ready with medical history, medications and allergies.

Make Friends with your Neighbor!
